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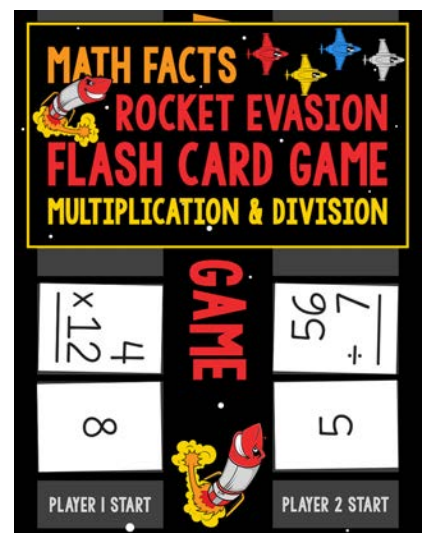
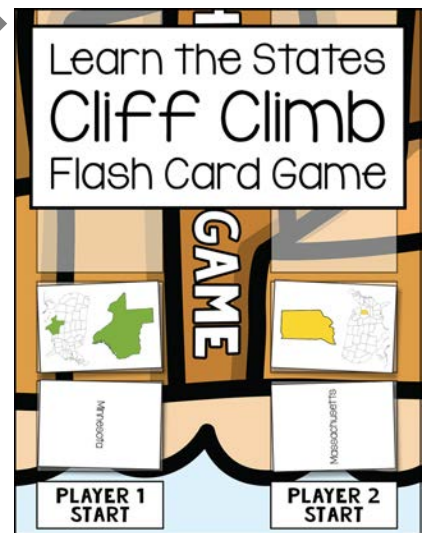
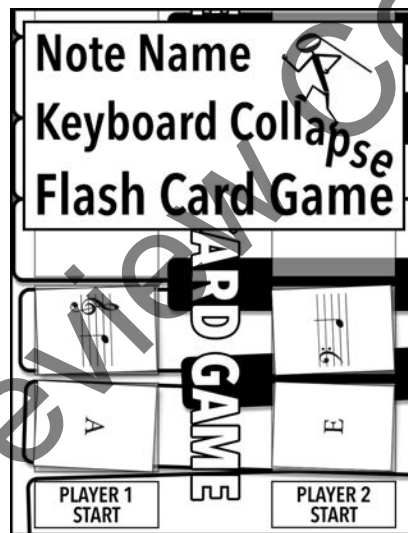
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Introduction

The *Animal Classification Escape the Volcano Flash Card Game* and its components will provide children with hours of learning enjoyment with regards to classifying animals by type. It focuses on vertebrates exclusively and covers the five main classes: mammals, birds, amphibians, reptiles and fish. Invertebrate flash cards that are compatible with this game are sold separately.

- 50 flash cards (ten for each class)
- Instructions for Assembly

If the children who will be playing the game are not familiar with the animal classes, you may want to show them the Animal Class Description Cards first and put a few of the flash cards under each card for example purposes. Also, when playing the game, you may want to start with cards from two classes initially and then work up to all five classes. Keep in mind that each player should have his own unique set of cards for game play so that players can't copy each other when giving answers. Solo play is an option as well.

Animal Class Description Cards

Instructions: Print on paper or card stock. Cut out cards on solid black lines. Laminate if desired.



Mammals

Mammals are warm-blooded animals that have fur or hair. They breathe air with lungs and have four limbs. They are born alive and produce milk for their young.



Birds

Birds are warm-blooded animals that breathe air. They have feathers, wings, and a beak. They lay eggs instead of giving birth.



Amphibians

Amphibians are cold-blooded animals that have moist skin and webbed feet. They live on both land and in the water. They lay their eggs in the water.



Reptiles

Reptiles are cold-blooded animals that have dry, scaly skin. They breathe air. Most reptiles lay eggs.



Fish

Fish are cold-blooded animals that live in the water. Most have scales and fins. Fish breathe underwater with gills and lay eggs in the water.
